Basic Mittens Materials

YARN

Vanna's Choice Yarn

Color: Oatmeal

Size: 4 weight/ worsted/ Aran

WPI = 10

OTHER MATERIALS

Crochet Hook H/8 - 5.00mm varn needle measuring tape scissors

DIMENSIONS

Cuff = 4 inches long Hand = 9 inches long Palm Circumference = 9 inches Appr. 232 yds of yarn for both mittens

Adult Size = One Size Fits Most

STITCH **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch / Chain sp/Space sc/ Single Crochet blo/ Back Loop Only flo/ Front Loop Only inc/ Increase Single Crochet means to make 2 sts in same st sp.

dec/ Decrease Single Crochet means to turn 2 sts into one.

sk/ Skip a stitch sl st/ Slip Stitch Rnd/ Round like row but not back and forth

Special Note:

- You want to work loose stitches for best comfort.
- Counting your stitches will prevent the dropping of stitches which is really easy to do. *Special Stitch:

For a straight join at the end of every row, release your crochet hook from the loop, insert your crochet hook into the top of the first stitch from back to front, insert hook in dropped loop, pull loop through stitch for your slip stitch to close round.

Instructions (Make 2)

CUFF

Ch 16

Row 1:

Sc in the second chain from your crochet hook. Make one sc in each stitch across. (Total 15 sts)

Row 2 - 32:

Ch 1, turn, sc blo across. (Total 15 sts)

AT THE END OF ROW 32, CH 1, TURN YOUR WORK, FOLD CUFF IN HALF SO THE FOUNDATION ROW IS TOUCHING ROW 32. SL ST THE FOUNDATION ROW AND ROW 32 TOGETHER TO CLOSE CUFF.

TURN CUFF INSIDE OUT SO THE JOIN IS NOT SO PRONOUNCED.

MOVE ON TO MAKING THE HAND SECTION.













HAND SECTION OF MITTEN

WE WILL BE WORKING ALONG THE SIDE OF THE ROWS OF THE CUFF.

WE ARE NOW WORKING IN ROUNDS.

Rnd 1:

Ch 1, make one sc in the side of the first 15 rows, inc sc in the side of the next 2 rows, sc in the last 15 rows.
SI st to close rnd 1.
(*refer to special stitch note)

Rnd 2:

Ch 1, sc in the first 15 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the next 2 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the last 15 sts.
SI st to close rnd.

Rnd 3:

Ch 1, sc in the first 15 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the next 4 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the last 15 sts.
SI st to close rnd.

Rnd 4:

Ch 1, sc in the first 15 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the next 6 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the last 15 sts.
SI st to close rnd.

Rnd 5:

Ch 1, sc in the first 15 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the next 8 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the last 15 sts.
SI st to close rnd.

Rnd 6:

Ch 1, sc in the first 15 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the next 10 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the last 15 sts.
SI st to close rnd.







HAND SECTION OF MITTEN

Rnd 7:

Ch 1, sc in the first 15 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the next 12 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the last 15 sts.
SI st to close rnd.

Rnd 8:

Ch 1, sc in the first 15 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the next 14 sts, inc sc in the next st, one sc in the last 15 sts.
SI st to close rnd.

Rnd 9 - 13:

Ch 1, sc in each st around. (Total 48 sts)

Rnd 14:

Ch 1, sc in the first 17 sts, sk next 14 sts, sc in the last 17 sts. SI st to close rnd. (Total 34 sts)

Rnd 15 - 34:

Ch 1, sc in each st around. SI st to close rnd. (Total 34 sts)

Rnd 35:

ch 1, [dec sc flo] around. SI st to close rnd. (Total 17 sts)

Rnd 36:

ch 1, [dec sc flo] around, sc in the last st. SI st to close rnd. (Total 9 sts)

CUT A LONG TAIL, WEAVE TAIL
IN AND OUT OF STITCHES IN
RND 36.
SYNCH CLOSED.
TIE KNOT.
WEAVE IN YOUR ENDS.







THUMB

SL ST IN THE FIRST ST OPEN NEXT TO THE PALM OF HAND. THIS WILL ATTACH THE YARN TO THE PROJECT

Rnd 1::

Ch 1, sc in each st around and one st in the main hand/palm section. SI st to close rnd. (Total 15 sts)

Rnd 2 - 9:

Ch 1, one sc in each st around. (Total 15 sts)

Rnd 10:

Ch 1, [dec sc flo] around.

End with one sc flo in the last st to close rnd.

sl st to close rnd.

CUT A LONG TAIL, WEAVE TAIL
IN AND OUT OF STITCHES IN
RND 10.
SYNCH CLOSED.
TIE KNOT.
WEAVE IN YOUR ENDS.


